Abstract: - Present study has to know contribution of top ten universities in uploading of theses and study has also focus on year wise growth of universities in Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with INFLIBNET and their contribution of theses in Shodhganga electronic theses and dissertation (ETD). This study has analyzed current scenario of Shodhganga with special reference to contribution of universities in Maharashtra. This study has selected all type of universities like state universities, Central Universities, Open Universities, Deemed universities.

Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET) Centre is an autonomous Inter- University Centre of the University Grants Commission (UGC) of India. It is a major National Programme initiated by the UGC in 1991 with its Head Quarters at Gujarat University Campus, Ahmedabad. Now center this is situated in Gandhinagar, Ahmedabad, Gujrat. Initially started as a project under the IUCAA, it became an independent Inter University Centre in 1996. INFLIBNET is involved in modernizing university and higher education institution libraries in India and connecting them as well as information centers in

the country through network using modern technologies for the optimum utilization of information. INFLIBNET is set out to be a major player in promoting scholarly communication among academicians and researchers in India. (INFLIBNET, 2019)

INFLIBNET fulfill the aims and objectives are made by UGC and MHRD the time of establishment of centre. INFLIBNET has introduce different type of activities and services to complete the objectives through the library development programme and support services to higher education in India. INFLIBNET started Union catalogue of Books, serials, theses, experts and research projects. Its name is IndCat (Online Indian Universities). union catalogue of **INFLIBNET** develop the **SOUL** library automation software for the each type of libraries. INFLIBNET is also contributing human resource development process and organize seminar, workshops, and trainings to the institutions, colleges, and universities to train their library staff. According to Devi and Singh it is necessary equip library manpower with all the knowledge, skills, and capabilities needed to handle library operations in the new digital environment. (Devi & Singh, 2006). Though INFLIBNET taking an effort to develop and equip skilled manpower in present era.

As per the observation of Karan and Das INFLIBNET centre is a boon of Indian Higher education. In the development of higher education INFLIBNET's role is very important from the post independent period. (Karn & Das, 2009)

SHODHGANGA

Shodhganga stands for the reservoir of Indian research output in the form of Ph.D. theses stored in a repository hosted and maintained by the INFLIBNET Centre. The Sanskrit word "Shodh" for discovery and research. The "Ganga" is the longest and holiest rivers in Indian. The Ganga is the symbol of India's age-long culture and civilization, ever-changing, ever-flowing, ever-loved and valued by its people. Shodhganga stands for the reservoir of Indian intellectual output stored in a repository hosted and maintained by the INFLIBNET Centre.

Current status of Shodhganga is 470 universities across India have signed Memorandum of Understanding with INFLIBNET for contribution their theses in Shodhganga. Till date 19th July 2019, 412 universities are uploading more than 234591 in theses Shodhganga and giving their contribution.

Dspace open source Digital repository software is used for maintenance and recording of resources in Shodhganga. DSpace which uses

internationally recognized protocols and interoperability standards. Shodhganga provides a platform for Indian Universities/ Institutions to deposit their Ph.D. theses and make it available to the entire scholarly community in open access. The repository has the ability to capture, index, store, disseminate and preserve ETDs (Electronic Theses and Dissertations) submitted by the researchers to their institutions.

This project is very important for the researcher. Theses and dissertations are known to be the rich and unique source of information. Such type of databases has save money, time and repetition of research work. It will also help researcher to avoid duplication.

REVIEW OF LITERATURE:

Vijayakumar J.K., Hosamani H. G. and Murthy T.V. (2003) have also depicts the purpose, benefits and coverage of theses and dissertation database of INFLIBNET. Ganesan A., (2016) found 58 percentage of users are familiar with using of INFLIBNET ETD Shodhganga. He organized suty on on User Awareness of INFLIBNET In Etd Shodhganga. Veer Dharmaraj K. and Khiste, Gajanan (2016) are discussed uploading strategy of theses and contribution of Maharashtra in Shodhganga. Das & Saikia (2014) examine that only 03 universities have joined Shodhganga out of 13 universities. These 3 universities contribution is also very poor. Study of ETD contribution in Shodhganga from West Bengal was conducted by Esh (2015). In his study

he analysed the university contribution and MoU, etc.

- To find out university wise number of ETD uploaded in Shodhganga from Maharashtra.

SCOPE

Scope of present study is Indian theses repository namely Shodhganga. It was selected for study. 470 universities are identified MoU with Inflibnet for this theses repository on 19 July 2019. Access date of Shodhganga is up to 19 July 2019. This study has analyzed scenario of Shodhganga with special reference to contribution of universities in Maharashtra. Present study has selected all type of universities like state universities, Central Universities, Open Universities, Deemed universities Government, Aided and private. Agricultural universities contribution is not found in Shodhganga from Mahrashtra.

RESEARCH METHODOLOGY

Present study has used descriptive research method for analyzing data collected from INFLIBNET website. (http://www.inflibnet.ac.in) on 19 July 2019,

DATA COLLECTION AND ANALYSIS

The data for the present study was collected from the Shodhganga repository from https://shodhganga.inflibnet.ac.in. Study has also specially focused on uploading contribution of universities from Maharashtra regional. This study has used tables and charts to analyze the data.


DATA FINDINGS & INTERPRETATIONS Top Ten universities: (19.7.2019)

Rank second is achieved by Savitribai Phule Pune University Pune form Maharashtra with contributing of 9837 (4.19% at all Indian and 36.06% at Maharashtra level) theses in Shodhganga ETD. Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad is also from Maharashtra in Top Ten university with ninth rank uploading 5156 theses. These two universities are contribution their best in Top Ten ranking of uploading work from Maharashtra.




Figure No. 2 Year wise participation and MoU of Indian Universities




Figure No.3 Year wise growth of ETD in Shodhganga

It can be observed from above Table No.4 the 31 universities have participated in ETD and they have signed MoU with Shodhganga. Out of 31 universities 13 state universities, 10 deemed universities contributed 24885 (10.60%) and 849 theses in Shodhganga from Maharashtra respectively. Contribution of all universities from Maharashtra is 27275 (11.62%) in Indian ETD Shodhganga up to 19.7.2019. Savitribai Phule Pune University ranked first with uploading 9837 (4.19% at all Indian and 36.06% at Maharashtra level) Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar theses. Marathwada University Aurangabad ranked second with contribution of 5156 (2.19% at all India and 18.90% at Maharashtra level) theses in shodhganga. Lowest only one Ph.D. Theses uploaded into Shodhganga by three Universities/ Institute i.e. Krishna Institute of Medical Sciences Deemed University, Karad and YashwantraoChavan Maharashtra Open University, Nashik and R. T. M. Nagpur University, Nagpur.

FINDINGS

- Calcutta University ranked first with uploading 11914 theses in shodhganga. Rank second is achieved by Savitribai Phule Pune University Pune form Maharashtra with contributing of 9837 and Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad is also from Maharashtra in Top Ten university with ninth rank uploading 5156 theses.
- Last ten years 467 Indian universities
 MoU with INFLIBNET for contribution of their ETD in Shodhganga.
- Indian universities contributed 234591 theses in shodhganga from last ten years i.e. from 2010 to 2019 (till date 19.7.2019). Growth of theses is increased day by day.
- Theses contribution of 13 state universities are 24885 (10.60%) and all universities contribution are 27275 (11.62% at India level) from maharashra.
- These 31 universities have uploaded 27275 (11.62% at India level) theses up to 19.7.2019. Savitribai Phule Pune University ranked first with uploading 9837 (4.19% at all Indian and 36.06% at Maharashtra level) theses. Second rank with 5156 (2.19% at all India and 18.90% at Maharashtra level) theses contribution by Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University Aurangabad

CONCLUSION

Shodhganga is project of INFLIBNET for collecting the theses and dessertations from Indian universities. Shodhganga is a boon for the research community. Shodhganga bring into light the hidden knowledge contained in the theses and dissertations. It is E-thesis repository in India providing open access to ETDs in various disciplines from across the nation. Shodhganga has become a reliance digital repository having a number of participants. Almost all universities are participated in Shodhganga ETD. Calcutta University ranked first with uploading 11914 theses in Shodhganga. Rank second and ninth is achieved by Savitribai Phule Pune University Pune form Maharashtra with contributing of 9837 (4.19%) theses and Dr.Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, Aurangabad with contributing 5156 (2.19%)from theses Maharashtr. The 31 universities and institutions for contributed MoU and signed are Shodhganga/INFLIBNET from Maharashtra. These 31 universities have uploaded 27275 (11.62%) theses up to 19.7.2019. Shodhganga facilitates quick retrieval of information and helps in avoiding duplication of research work. It also helps the researcher to understand various themes of research.
