SNDT Women's University

SNDT Women's University is the first Women's university in India as well as in South-East Asia.

The University was founded by Maharshi Dr. Dhondo Keshav Karve in 1916 for a noble cause of Women's Education. The University Headquarters is in Churchgate Campus, Mumbai and the other two campuses of this University are at Juhu, Mumbai and Karve Road, Pune. In addition to 37 university departments and 13 constituent colleges/ institutions located on three campuses, it has 174 affiliated colleges in Maharashtra, Gujrat, Goa, Madhya Pradesh, Uttar Pradesh that has an enrolment of over 70,000 students in various programmes.

Knowledge Resource Centre (KRC), SNDT Women's University

The Knowledge Resource Centre (SNDT Women's University Library) was established in 1955. The KRCs comprise of three campus libraries and a children's library at Juhu. The KRCs have myriad resources like books, e-books, journals, e-journals, theses and dissertations, resorts, reprints, etc. there are 4 Lakh books in these libraries and approximately 550 journals and 15 online databases giving access to 1500000 journals and international theses. It serves the students, teachers and researchers through its various information and documentation activities.

The SHPT School of Library Science founded in 1961, is a Department of the SNDT Women's University in Churchgate Campus. The Department offers Master of Library & Information Science (M.L.I.Sc.) and Ph.D in Library and Information Science.
